

## SENTENCE-PHRASE-WORD

In your discussion group, review the text that you have read and each select your own:

- Sentence that was meaningful to you, that you felt captures a core idea of the text
- Phrase that moved, engaged, or provoked you
- Word that captured your attention or struck you as powerful.

As a group, discuss and record your choices. Begin by each sharing your sentences, then phrases, then words. Explain why you made the selections you did. Looking at your group's collective choice of words, phrases, and sentences, reflect on the conversation by identifying:

- What themes emerge?
- What big ideas seem important here?
- Were there aspects of the text not captured in your choices?
